Coaches Code of Ethics





I coach because I want to help young people mature into well adjusted, productive adults with strong character. I want to foster a love for the fun, exciting game of soccer.

I will be an encourager, not a discourager.

My actions and personal manner will be a good example for young people to follow.

- I will treat all players, coaches, administrators, parents and referees with the respect and courtesy I desire for myself.
- Any dissatisfaction I want to express will be stated in a private forum and in a restrained and civil manner.
- I will respect and honor the beliefs and sensitivities of all players, coaches, parents, administrators, and referees.

Regardless of how teams are formed, I recognize that all players on my team have value, both as Players, and as people.

- I recognize that all have signed up to play, not watch, and except for health reasons, I am committed to playing each player at least fifty percent of the game and in a manner that seems fair to all players and parents.
- As a coach, it is not appropriate for me to teach the players "life is not fair"; they will learn enough of that on their own. My job is to make the soccer part of their life as fair as possible, no matter what the level of competition.

I will be prepared for each game and practice.

- For practices, I will have a practice plan that efficiently uses the time available and teaches the players important skills and strategies for the game of soccer.
- For games, I will have a game plan that will utilize the talents of all my players to the utmost while ensuring that each player feels needed and respected.

I will follow all the Laws of the Game and will abide by all the administrative procedures of KYSC, KYSA, South Texas Youth Soccer Association, United States Youth Soccer, and the United States Soccer Federation.

Coaching Requirements

This info can be found under the Coaches tab on the KYSC Website.

ALL COACHES and ASST. COACHES must create a GotSport account. Once you have setup an account, you will need to re-register each season (Spring and Fall). Please click HERE > Team & Team Officials > Individual Coach

All former and new coaches /Asst. coaches are REQUIRED to:

- Successfully register and pass a <u>BACKGROUND CHECK</u> (Every 2 years)
- Complete the <u>SAFESPORT</u> training modules. (Every year; Refresher after 1st year)
- Complete the <u>CDC Heads Up Concussion Awareness</u> Training (Every 2 years)

All components are mandatory in order for the adult to receive a KidSafe Participation pass to be added to your team as a coach. Components 2, 3 and 4 are linked through the individual's GotSoccer account.








Coaching Requirements

Mandatory for ALL Coaches and Assistant Coaches on Team:

- Register with KYSC
- Register in GotSport
- Complete STYSA KidSafe Adult Registration for background check (GotSport)
- Complete the CDC Heads Up concussion training (GotSport)
- Complete the SafeSport Certification training (GotSport)

Who should register as a Coach with KYSC?

- All former Coaches, and anyone who wants to coach for KYSC, must register with KYSC before they are assigned to a team.
- Please note that registering as a coach does not guarantee you a team.



Coaching Requirements

When do coaches have to complete their background check?

Coaches must complete their background check before they can be assigned a team.

When do coaches have to complete their SafeSport and CDC Concussion?

Coaches must complete their Safesport and CDC training before the 2nd game of the season.

What happens if a coach does not complete their background checks before the deadline?

If a coach does not complete their background before the 2nd game, they will be suspended for one week and each week after until it is completed.

Where can I pick up my Coaches Badge?

Badges will be printed tonight for those with completed requirements. Other badges will be available at the board tent for the first game.

There will be no leniency on this policy.

We will have badge holders and lanyards at the board tent if you need one



Escalation Process

Initial Reminder: If a coach has not completed the required training by the specified deadline, a formal reminder will be issued, clearly stating the importance of completing the training promptly. This reminder should include the deadline for compliance and information on how to access the training.

Escalation Process:

- **First Escalation**: If the training is still not completed after the initial reminder, the coach will receive a direct communication from the AC and VP of Coaches. This communication will emphasize the critical nature of the training and the potential consequences of non-compliance. (before the first game)
- **Second Escalation**: Should the coach fail to comply after the first escalation, the President will contact the coach and will be given a final opportunity to complete the training within a specified timeframe. (This occurs mid-week after the first escalation). The coach will be given a deadline to complete all required items by Friday, prior to the next game.

Enforcement and Removal:

- If all escalations and warnings have been exhausted without compliance, the coach will be removed from their position until items are completed, or a replacement can be found. This action is necessary to protect the organization.
- The removal process will be documented thoroughly, ensuring that all steps were taken to provide the coach with ample opportunity to comply, signed off by the VP of Coaches and the President (we can create a form that the President and the VP of Coaches must sign to confirm that we have reviewed and verified that all policies, including the documentation of compliance requirements and escalation steps were followed.)

Monitoring: The VP of Coaches will implement regular monitoring to ensure all coaches remain compliant with training requirements. Any future instances of non-compliance will be handled swiftly following this established procedure.



- Fields are OPEN; lights on until 9:45 pm Monday Thursday
- Katy Park Shift Change Rule See Coaches Manual
 - * Katy Park field shift change occurs **EVERY** weeknight at 7:00pm.
 - * Your team MUST give up the field to an awaiting team at 7:00pm irrespective of the time you started.
- It is recommended that practice sessions be scheduled for 5:30–7:00 pm and 7:00–8:30 pm to gain maximum use of the facilities.

Katy Park Park Traffic INFO

- Yes, there will be traffic on game day.

Scheduling

Official schedule will be posted on www.katyyouthsoccer.com

- First week will be posted Monday prior to the first game
- The remainder of schedule will be posted before the second match.
- Check the website **EVERY** Friday for any schedule changes.
- Game times will be coordinated for <u>Head Coaches</u> with multiple teams.

Rescheduling games will be at the discretion of KYSC

Situation <u>MUST</u> impact the <u>majority</u> of team.

An absent Coach is not a reason to reschedule

- Coaches get ONE request to reschedule ONE game.
- Make initial requests to the AC; and CC respective VP on email.
- Request <u>MUST</u> be made <u>BEFORE</u> the second game.
- Requests are not guaranteed.





Sponsorship


- Sponsorships are \$200

Referee

THE MAJORITY OF KYSC REFEREES ARE TEENAGERS!!!!

- o BE RESPECTFUL
- o **DO NOT** use Foul language
- o **DO NOT** touch or physically harm anyone

DISAGREEMENT WITH CALLS OR SCORES

- o Referee calls are **FINAL**.
- o Issues **CANNOT** be resolved after the game.
- o You can contact your AC about the disagreement.
- o Scores and calls will <u>NOT</u> be reversed, but your reporting of information will help KYSC to address learning gaps with refs.

RED AND YELLOW CARDS

- o Referees can issue red/yellow cards on players and coaches at any point during a match.
- o Coaches will be carded for unruly parents and spectators

Parents on Game Day

COACHES, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR PARENTS' BEHAVIOR ON GAME DAYS!!

- o It is **NOT** the Referee's responsibility to control the parents
- o Referees WILL yellow card and/or red card Coaches for sideline disturbances

BE RESPECTFUL

- o **DO NOT** use Foul language
- o DO NOT use racial or discrimination language
- o **DO NOT** use negative language
- o **DO NOT** touch or physically harm any kids

LOCATION

- o MUST be located on the opposite side of field from the coaches/players
- o Do **NOT** stand behind/beside the goals
- o Do **NOT** come onto the field during the game for any reason



STOPPAGE OF GAME PLAY

- o Referees can stop the game due to lack of parent control or sideline disturbances that disrupt the game
- o Games will **NOT** be replayed and the current score will stand



Sportsmanship Point Don't forget the sportsmanship point

o Please do your best to make the game <u>FUN</u> for <u>ALL</u> players.

o If your team is dominating a game by more than 4 goals it is time to get creative.

- * Play your defense up top.
- * Play your goalie as your forward.
- * Rotate in your players that might need the extra touches on the ball.

* Sit your "star" players or maybe let them "coach" (great way to build their understanding of the game)

There are good ways to win and bad ways to win.

Coaches Meeting "Takeaways"

ALL coaches, including assistants, must sign up with KYSC, must be registered in GotSport, must complete the Background Check, SafeSport, and CDC Concussion training

- Links are found on KYSC website under **COACHES** tab.
- Your background check has to be completed and clear before you get a team.
- YOU are responsible for your printed roster and coach badge.
- SafeSport, CDC, and background <u>MUST</u> be completed before the <u>SECOND</u> game,
 - (See Coaches Manual for discipline policy)
- Shift Change at Katy Park; Practice guidelines (located in the Coaches Manual)
 - Occurs <u>EVERY</u> weeknight at 7:00 pm;
 - You <u>MUST</u> vacate your practice area at 7:00pm & surrender it to another team;
 please plan accordingly.
- Find practice space anywhere you can. You only need grass, a ball, and some kiddos.
- ALL players <u>MUST</u> play at least <u>50%</u> of <u>EVERY</u> game; <u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>
- Don't forget the sportsmanship point!
